The B-25 Mitchell was one of the most numerous used medium bombers in WWII. It fought with three major users, the Americans, the Soviets and the British. However other countries received Mitchells during the war, including Australia with 50 aircraft on charge, most of which came from Dutch orders. They were used by a single unit, No 2Sq in the Pacific. With over 30 photographs, the book is a very good reference for modelers and historians. Published as No. 9 in the series 'Allied Wings'
